



## First Responders

Law Enforcement Officers will need to have their Police Chief, Fire Chief, Sheriff or Administrator to submit their application to the Ranch.

The Ranch will never turn a First Responder away for treatment!

If a Law Enforcement Officer shoots someone in the Line of Duty, they can stay on the Ranch for additional time.

The Rusty Old Ranch will charge First Responder Agencies 1/4<sup>th</sup> of what they are currently budgeted for.

Any First Responder Agency with less than 9 full time employees, will not be charged for care.

First Responders are authorized to attend any of our therapies.

## Funding

The Rusty Old Ranch will be operated as a Not-for-Profit Organization, with its own 501C3 number.

The Ranch Grant Writers will write grants. Staff Members will also be soliciting donations to help fund the Ranch.

## Who are we?

The Rusty Old Ranch, Inc, was setup and organized by Rusty Johnson and a group of his friends. They came up with the idea of helping Veterans, First Responders and Disabled Children.

These individuals have years of experience of working with Veterans, First Responders and Disabled Children.

And they came up with the following activities for the Ranch:

## Mental Health Care

There will be 5 Mental Health Care Doctors on Staff at the Ranch. One Doctor will be on call 24/7. Clients can attend Counseling as much as needed each day.

## Mental Health Care Therapies

**The Rusty Old Ranch will cover the following therapies:**

- Archery Therapy
- Aquatic Therapy
- Art Therapy
- Equestrian Therapy
- Fishing Therapy
- Information Technology Therapy
- Karate Therapy
- Wood Working Therapy

Clients are free to choose on which and how ever many therapies they want to try out.

## Veterans

Over 79% of Veterans refuse to go to the Veterans Administration Hospitals. They are afraid they will be committed involuntarily. Or that they will take away their guns.

**The Ranch does not, will not report to the Veterans Administration!**

Veterans do not have to have a disability rating to attend the Ranch.

## Homeless Veterans

The Rusty Old Ranch will work with the Indiana Department of Veterans Affairs to house and feed Homeless Veterans. These Veterans will also be able to attend therapy classes and Mental Health Therapy as needed.

The Veterans will be cleaned up, given new clothes, housed and fed.

The Ranch Staff will hire the Homeless Veterans to work on the Ranch. They will be able to earn up to \$1,500.00 a month. A financial Counselor will be available once a week to work with the Veterans on how to save their money.

The Ranch Staff will assist the Veterans in finding employment anywhere in the State of Indiana. The Ranch will provide transportation to and from the business free of charge for the Veteran and/or Veterans family members.

For Veterans who are disabled and cannot work, the Chaplains on the Ranch will assist them with applying for their VA disability rating, free of charge. The Chaplains can also assist the Veterans with their Social Security benefits.
